U. S. Steel Report

CLEVELAND, (AP) - Demand from the automotive industry, biggest consumer of steel, continued to lag and steel ingot production last week hit a low point for the year, Steel magazine reported today. The weekly magazine of metalworking said output declined 2.5 points last week to 70 per cent of capacity, or 1,670,000 net tons. That compares with a 75.5 per cent of capacity operation in January.

Sales to shipbuilders and railway car producers also are slow, and orders from farm implement makers are not showing as much seasonal pick-up as usual. A firm spot in the picture is the good and steady demand for steel by producers of barges and towboats, the magazine added. Steel's price composite on finished steel held firm at \$113.91 a net ton for the 11th straight week during the week ended March 4.

There is a growing inclination of consumers to haggle over prices and order on a "rush" basis. The magazine's composite price on steelmaking scrap continued to drop with the decline in steel mill output. It was down \$1 from the preceding week to \$24.50 a gross ton at the end of last week.

Mr., Mrs. Canada Heading Home From Moscow

By BILL BOSS Canadian Press Staff Writer MOSCOW, (CP) - The couple who for two years have been "Mr. and Mrs. Canada" in Moscow are heading home. Robert Ford, charge d'affaires at the Canadian embassy since February, 1951, turns over his office to newly-designated ambassador John Watkins on Wednesday. Watkins, who has held two earlier appointments in Moscow, comes here from Oslo and the bachelor ambassador was scheduled to meet Mr. and Mrs. Ford in Helsinki, Finland, Monday and discuss the turn-over with them.

Here as charge d'affaires before Ford, Watkins knows his new home well, but despite recent extensive renovations the Fords will have to forewarn him about burst pipes, water leaking through the replastered dining room ceiling, buckling tiles and a lopsided sink in the bathroom, and unmatched electrical fixtures in the halls. The dilapidated-looking "Canada House" on Stara-Konyushni street originally was the home of two wealthy sugar-merchant brothers. The building was the Danish legation before the Second World War and was acquired by Canada during the war when the Danes left after Germany occupied their country.

New York Stocks

NEW YORK, (AP) - Is the stock market headed for a big spring rally? That's a question being asked in Wall Street as a result of the surprising strength shown by the market last week. The market on average came within a short distance of establishing a high mark for the last 84 years' composite price.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks in its second strongest showing of this year advanced to \$116.20. At that point the market was only 10 cents under the 1933-54 high mark of Jan. 5, 1953. That was the best since June 4, 1930.

Since mid-September of last year the market has been advancing steadily. A pertinent question is when will the reaction begin? Brokers agree that the market can't keep going up forever without a setback.

Current strength, however, has led many to believe that the market is capable of swinging into a spring rally first.

There is still the stumbling block of March 15. If enough people find it necessary to sell stocks for cash to meet income tax payments this week, that might provide an excuse for the market to start backing down.

Canadian stocks were mixed as the week's trading ended. Dome Mines dropped 1-2 and Distillers Secgram eased 3-8. McIntyre and Hiram Walker firmed 1-4.

On the American stock exchange Lake Shore eased 1-4.

More Nurses For U. N. Needed

MONTREAL, (CP) - Miss Lyle Creelman, nursing consultant in Geneva for the World Health Organization, said Friday a trip across Canada to interview nurses interested in working for the United Nations body was "a success but we still need more nurses." Miss Creelman, with W. H. O. since 1949, said the main work of the organization is helping to set up and improve schools for nurses so member countries can have their own nurses.

There were 82 member countries in the specialized agency, formed to assist countries with their health problems. It had about 130 nurses, including some 30 Canadians, working in 34 countries. Miss Creelman, who arrived in Vancouver Feb. 4 from Geneva, said there is a shortage of nurses in Canada but it is "rather relative."

when other diplomats plan functions. Ford, a quiet-speaking, tall, dark man of 39, is highly regarded by his colleagues in the diplomatic corps. Not many chiefs of mission here are linguists but Ford speaks Russian, French, Spanish and Portuguese well and has a working knowledge of German.

Son of Arthur Ford, editor-in-chief of the London Free Press, he is a graduate of University of Western Ontario and Cornell University, where he was assistant lecturer in history.

He joined the department of external affairs in 1941, was in Rio de Janeiro from 1941 to 1945, attended the first General Assembly of the United Nations in London in 1945 and there met his wife, a member of the Brazilian delegation. They were married in the United States and came to Moscow for the first time in 1946.

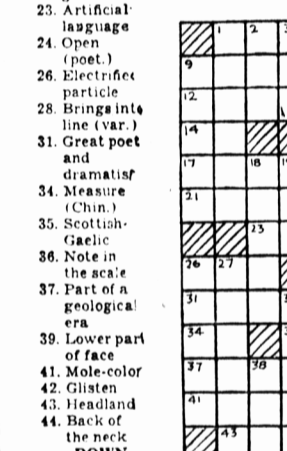
His next assignment is the European desk in the external affairs department in Ottawa.

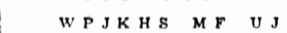

Eight Henchmen Of Sicilian Bandit King Poisoned

PALERMO, Sicily, (AP) - Eight henchmen of the slain Sicilian bandit king, Salvatore Giuliano, fell to the floor writhing in pain half-way through their noon meal in prison here Wednesday. One of them died and the police said Thursday all eight were poisoned. It was the second poison death in the local prison among the lieutenants of the fabulous bandit whose gang held Sicily in a reign of terror for years until he was killed in 1950.

The man who claimed to have done the killing—Giuliano's cousin, Gaspare Pisciotta—died suddenly last week while drinking his morning coffee. A prison guard is being held on suspicion of murder. The man who died Wednesday was Angelo Russo, one of Pisciotta's closest associates.
