running a survey and ask her name.

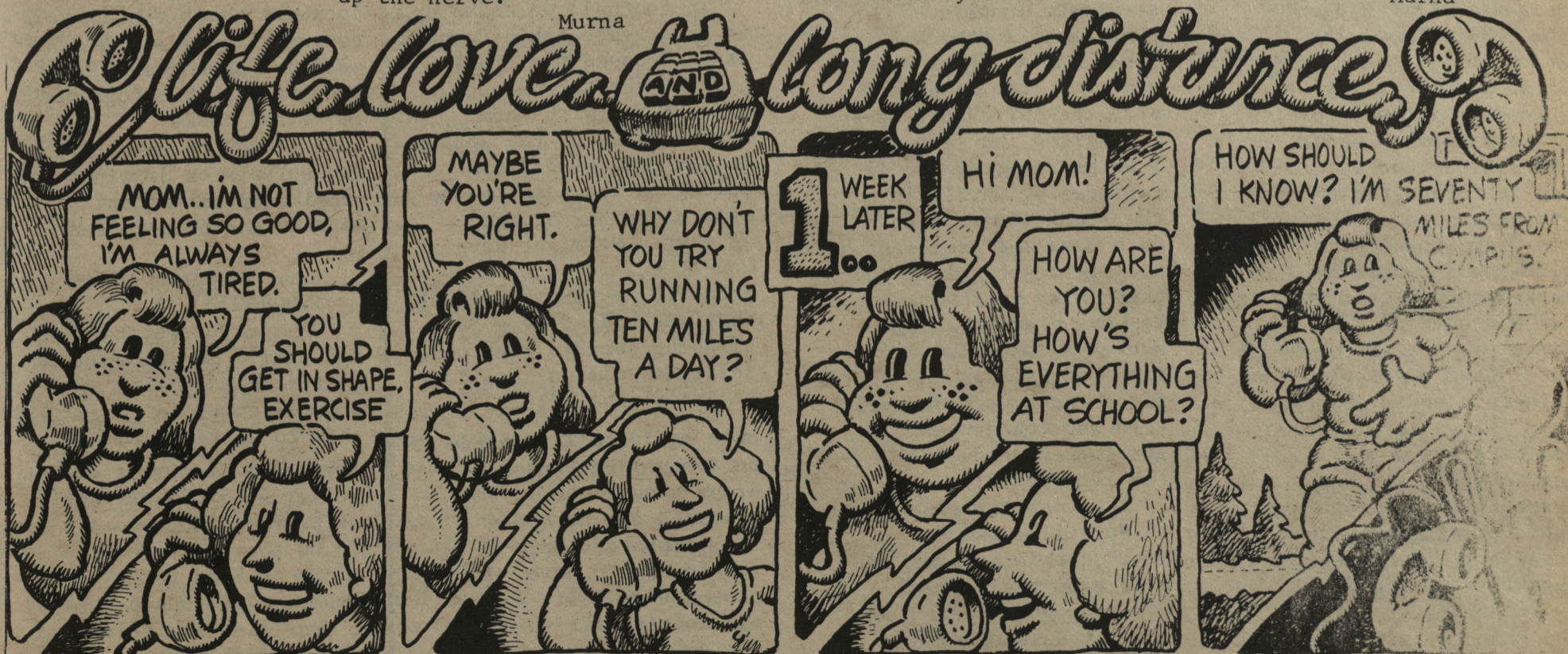
2. Pretend you are selling lottery tickets and get her to buy one, give it to her if she has no money, (she has to sign her name).
