



Tourist Fund Exhausted, Mr. MacDonald Reports

The tourist loan fund through which the Island Government makes loans available to prospective or established owners of tourist resorts has been exhausted and overdrawn on last year's applications, Hon. B. Earle MacDonald told the Legislature yesterday as he resumed the debate on the draft address.

Mr. MacDonald said he would ask for permission to increase the fund by \$150,000 but this did not mean that all people who thought they could make a good job of running such a business would be eligible to borrow from it.
