N. Y. Market Recovers After Selling Squall NEW YORK, April 11 (AP)—A late selling squall drenched the stock market today. In a few minutes leading shares fell fractions to around two points in heavy trading. The storm blew over before serious damage was done and recovery got under way almost immediately. Final prices were above the lows of the day for many stocks. A handful of shares showed independent strength, closing with gains running to more than a point. The late activity helped to boost turnover for the day to 2,010,000 shares just under yesterday's 2,070,000. The market had shown a tendency to slip ever since the opening. There was no pronounced weakness, though, and losses generally were limited to small fractions. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks dropped 6 of one point to 75.5, the largest setback since March 30. Canadian issues were higher. McIntyre added 1-2. Canadian Pacific and Dome Mines each gained 1/8. Hiram Walker and Distillers Seagrams each eased 1-8. On the Curb, Royalite Oil dropped 1-2. Lake Shore Mines were unchanged and Grant Yellowknife was up 1-8. Lower were Imperial Oil and Calgary and Edmonton Corporation.

EN ROUTE TO ROME OTTAWA, April 11 (CP)— Most Rev. Alexandre Vachon, Roman Catholic Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Ottawa, left today for Saint John, N. B., where he will embark Thursday on a trip to Rome. Archbishop Vachon will be present at holy year ceremonies. Before leaving the Basilica here he officiated at a brief service of supplication for the success of his journey and his safe return.
