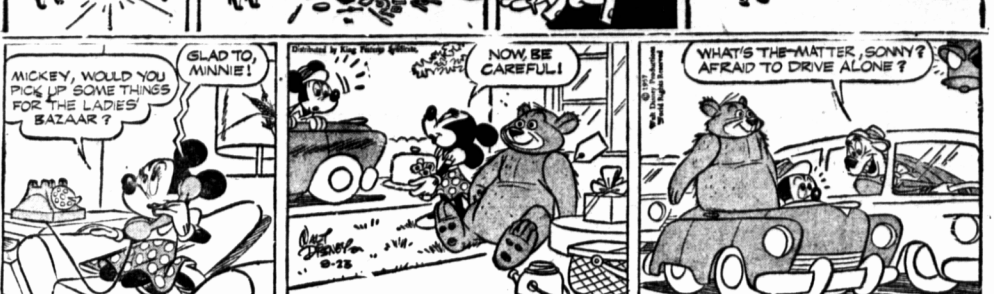

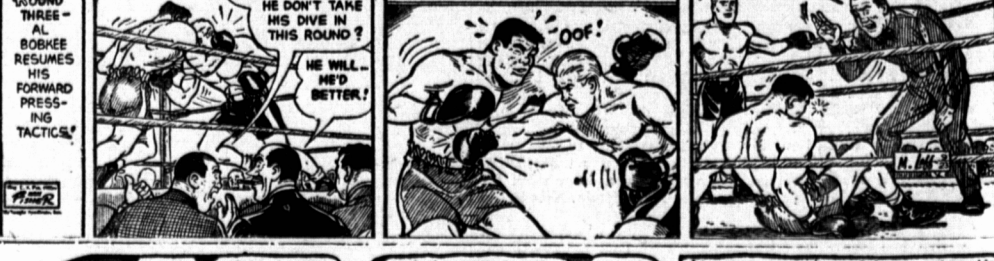

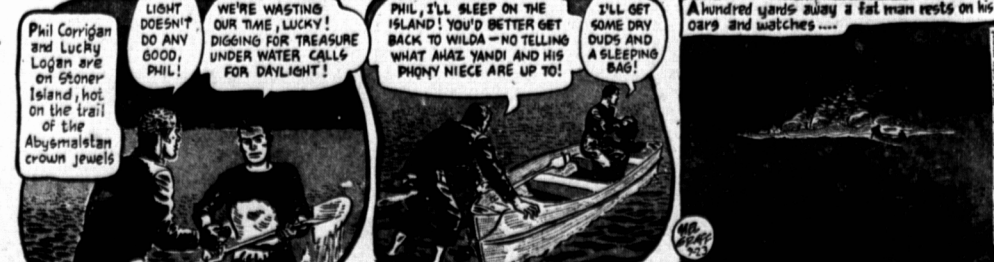

Anti-Inflation Bd. Named In US

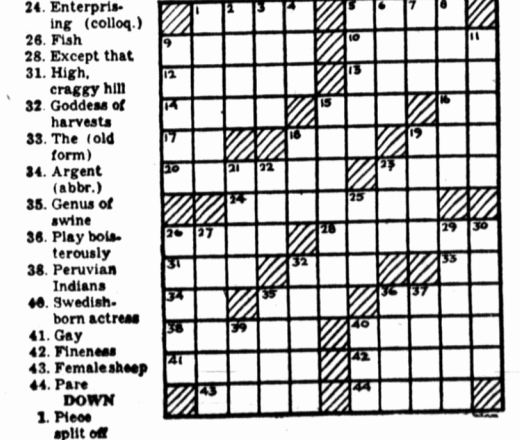
WASHINGTON (AP) — Establishment of a top level government strategy board to combat inflation, which President Eisenhower calls "our major internal problem," was announced Friday. Treasury Secretary Robert B. Anderson said the group will meet with Eisenhower from time to time to review and exchange ideas about "the financial aspects" of the economy of the U.S.

The regular consultants in addition to Anderson will include William M. Martin Jr., chairman of the Federal Reserve Board, Raymond J. Saulnier, chairman of the president's council of economic advisers, and Dr. Gabriel Hauge, Eisenhower's special assistant for economic affairs. Other officials will be brought in on some occasions, Anderson said, to provide "full discussion and interchange of views in connection with whatever developments may be occurring at the time."

Eisenhower frequently expressed concern at the steady rise in consumer prices. He told his press conference Sept. 3 that while he was not advocating any buyers' strike "we should not be spending recklessly and adding fuel to this flame. Democrats are planning to make the cost of living a prime campaign issue, blaming it on Eisenhower policies. The idea of regular consultations at the top level was understood to have originated with Anderson and to have been adopted enthusiastically by the president. Officials said they expect the meetings will take place at least once a month, although no regular schedule is contemplated.

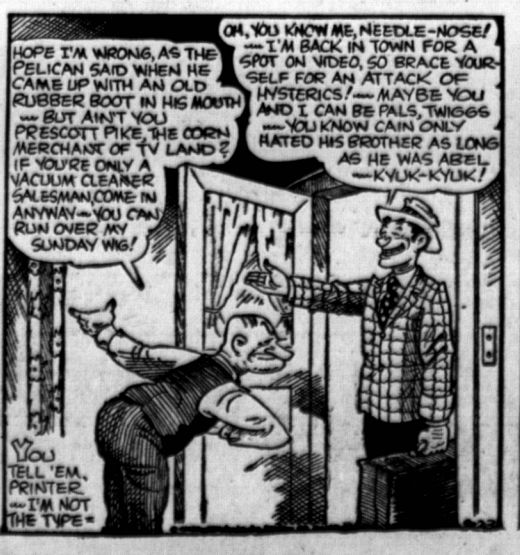
