Quebec Byelections Watched To Indicate Political Wind

QUEBEC (CP)—Politicians are holding their wetted fingers to the political breeze waiting out of two rural ridings where provincial byelections are to be held Oct. 5.

The byelections are regarded as the first real test of the Liberal government's popularity since a snap general election in 1962 consolidated the party's position in the legislature.

In one riding—Dorchester—there may also be some indication of the Rallemont des Creche's popularity in the provincial field.

There are four byelections in the villages of Dorchester and Matane where discontent is said to be

rumbling, that people who study ridings will watch particularly. Farmers are reported disturbed about dropping revenues and increasing school taxes. In June, 10,000 of them massed in front of the legislature in the largest protest march ever held in the provincial capital.

The government quickly passed legislation cutting real estate taxes of farmers by 25 per cent.

But farm spokesmen say this was only temporary relief because farmers are taxed for their land as well as for their homes with the result they lose more taxes while getting less income than their neighbors in the villages.

In addition to Dorchester, and Matane, the byelection ridings are Saguenay and Mont-real Verdun. All but Dorchester elected Liberals in 1962.

Matane, in the lower St. Lawrence south shore region, and Dorchester, south of Quebec City, are areas of marginal farms on rocky land.

Matane has been trying to get new industry to replace pulp mills that flourished until a few years ago. In 1962 the Liberal cabinet agreed by 130 votes, reduced from a comfortable majority of 1210 two years before.

Dorchester was the *hef* of Joseph D. Began from 1955 until 1962 when the former Union National cabinet minister and

first party organizer retired from active politics. The riding at that time in addition to stiff penalties for infractions, it provides part payment of some candidates' campaign expenses and puts tighter limits on election spending. Under the law, By-elections will vote for the first time.

Standing in the 95-seat assembly is Liberals 59, Union National 20, Independent one, vacant five. The fifth vacancy was created by the recent resignation of Cullivra Affairs Minister Georges Lapalme.
