

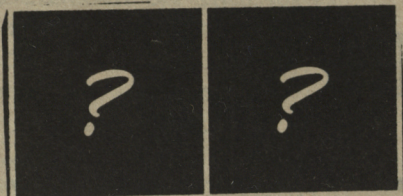


# CAMPUS COMMENT



QUESTION: Do you believe in Gnomes?

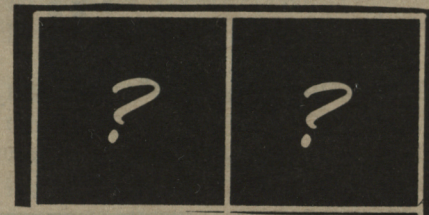
Sonny - Freshman, Engineering

They have done an adequate job. Though it may not appear so to the public eye, a lot has been done this year.

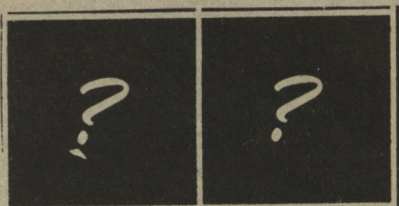


Judy MacDonald - Soph, Arts
