

Audition for 'The Hostage'

The University Theatre Society has announced its long-awaited auditions for this year's play, Brendan Behan's *The Hostage*.

The auditions are being held in the Faculty Lounge Main Building, from 7:30 to 10:00 p.m. on Monday, January 20. Those unable to attend these times should see Ian MacDonald, Director of Extension, who is the play's producer.

According to Mr. MacDonald, there are many acting parts available, both big and small. There are also parts for people who can sing or dance "after a fashion." No previous experiences is necessary, but auditioners will be asked to read from the play and to read something of their own choosing if possible.

Mr. MacDonald describes *The Hostage* as "a rollicking sort of comedy by a wild Irish rogue." But he

is quick to point out that the play has a serious message as well. "This story is about a young English soldier being held as a hostage by the I.R.A. in exchange for an I.R.A. man scheduled to be hanged. There is anger behind it. But what Behan really says is 'a plague on both your houses - love is what matters.'"

Despite the sombre setting *The Hostage* has been described as "magnificent entertainment." It is full of ballads, satirical songs, dancing and general Irish wit, romance, and shenanigans. The play has won several awards since its first performance in 1958.

Brendan Behan, the author who once did time in a British prison, maintained that he had "a total irreverence for anything connected with society except anything which makes the roads safer, the beer stranger, ... the

food cheaper, and old men and women warmer in winter and happier in summer."

U.P.E.I.'s production is directed by Ronald Irving

who has had considerable experience working with both amateur and professional actors. He has directed or advised several productions at the university

including last year's *As you Like It*. His most recent professional triumph was his direction of the highly acclaimed *La Sagouine* in Montreal, Ottawa, and Toronto. Mr. Irving has now been appointed director to Island Community Theatre, Inc., dedicated to fostering local theatre on Prince Edward Island.
