Dulles' Condition Said Excellent

WASHINGTON (AP)—State Secretary Dulles was reported in "excellent" condition Monday in his recovery from surgery for the removal of an intestinal cancer. The state department said Dulles may return to his desk sooner than expected. Early medical bulletins said Dulles, barring complications, could return to his state department duties in about six weeks. Press officer Lincoln White said Monday: "If the favorable recovery continues and barring unforeseen complications, the secretary may be able to leave the hospital and with a normal period of convalescence, return to his duties sooner than previous estimates."
