The Alpine Good Night.

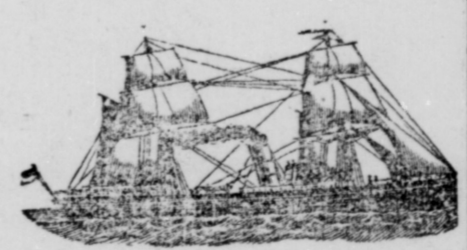

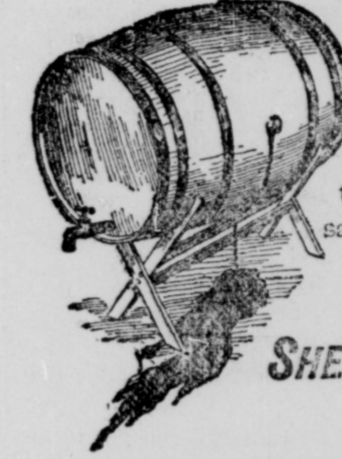
