1903 WINNER
The 1903 winner was Arthur Garfield Cameron who became a barrister and practiced in Trail, B.C. The 1907 scholar was R.A.D. Gillis who became a physician.

1908 WINNER
Roy Leitch was the 1908 winner, last known to be in Halifax. The 1909 winner was Joseph Daly, later a physician in Toronto.

1910 WINNER
Daniel Cobb Harvey won scholarship in 1910, went on to become a professor of history and a special lecturer at Dalhousie. H.C. Warburton was awarded in 1911 then served in the colonial service in Nigeria. He was drowned in 1917.

1912 WINNER
There were two Rhodes Scholarships granted in 1912, 1918, 1921, 1922, 1924. It is not known whether this was because of lack of applicants, or because those applying did not measure up to the standards required.

1913 WINNER
In 1913, the winner was A.L. Collett of Victoria, who was a lieutenant in the Canadian Infantry and Gloucester Regiment in World War One and who died of wounds in September, 1917.

1914 WINNER
The 1914 winner was Alfred Tennyson Seaman, who later served with the department of trade and commerce in Ottawa. A. Paul won the scholarship in 1915, but did not take it up after the war.

1915 WINNER
Cuthbert A. Simpson was the 1915 winner. He later became a minister with the Protestant Episcopal Church and was a professor of the old testament at the General Theological Seminary in New York City.

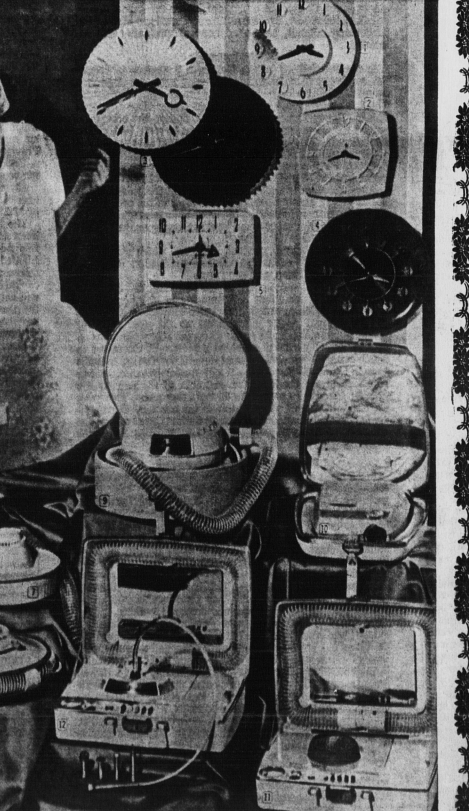
