

Common Grackle - 1 on Feb. 9 and 2 on Feb. 13, both in Bunbury (SEV).

Pine Grosbeak - 1 at Newland Cresc. in Charlottetown on Feb. 7 and 7 at Milltown Cross on Feb. 14 (WEC).

Common Redpoll - 2 at her feeder on Jan. 19 (LW); 2 at Indian River on Jan. 28 (TC).

Song Sparrow - 1 in Bunbury on Feb. 9 (SEV).

Lapland Longspur - some in Tyne Valley on Feb. 1 (GR); about 20 at North Lake on Feb. 14 (WEC).

Snow Bunting - several flocks of 20 to 50 birds in the Alexandra area on Jan. 22 (GH); 200 in St. Peter's West on Feb. 8 (WEC).

FEEDER REPORT

Dumville Feeder - Cornwall, Jan. 25. 1m + 1f Hairy Woodpecker, 1m + 1f Downy Woodpecker, 1m + 1f White-breasted Nuthatch, 5 Common Redpoll, 2 White-throated Sparrow, plus regulars of several more common species.

Barrett Feeder - New Dominion, Jan. 28. 1m Hairy Woodpecker, 1m + 1f Downy Woodpecker, several Bluejay, 10 Black-capped Chickadee, 1 Red-breasted Nuthatch, 2 Common Starling, 2m Evening Grosbeak, plus 1 pesky red squirrel. Mr. Barrett also mentions that his dog recently captured a flying squirrel.

Holman Feeder - 153 North River Road, Charlottetown, late January. 5 Rock Dove, 2 Downy Woodpecker, 1 Bluejay, 3 Common Crow, 5 Black-capped Chickadee, 1 White-breasted Nuthatch, 15 Common Starling, 12 House Sparrow, 30-40 Evening Grosbeak, 11 Common Redpoll, 15 American Goldfinch, 1 Dark-eyed Junco, 2 White-throated Sparrow.

Eckford/Holman Feeder - Heatherdale, late January. up to 15 Bluejay, 12-15 Dark-eyed Junco, 3 White-throated Sparrow.

Keaveny Feeder - York Point. 1 Sharp-shinned Hawk flew into window on Jan. 27. 1 Goshawk and 1 red fox on Jan. 30.

Mancuso Feeder - Orchard Hill Park, late January. 3-4 Bluejay, 3 Common Crow, 8-10 Black-capped Chickadee, 2 White-breasted Nuthatch, 20-30 Evening Grosbeak, 10 American Goldfinch plus 2 red squirrel.

Andrew Feeder - Milltown Cross, early February. 12 Gray Partridge, 20 Bluejay, 4 Common Crow, 2 Black-capped Chickadee, 1 Red-breasted Nuthatch.

Clark Feeder - Indian River, Feb. 13. 1m Common Merganser in the brook, 4 (formerly up to 8) Gray Partridge, 1 Hairy Woodpecker, 2m + 2f Downy Woodpecker, over 30 Bluejay, 15 Black-capped Chickadee, 2 Boreal Chickadee, 2m + 2f Red-breasted Nuthatch, 1 Brown Creeper, 24 House Sparrow, 30 Evening Grosbeak, 11 Common Redpoll, 12 Dark-eyed Junco, 5 Tree Sparrow, plus 8 red squirrel, a black pink on the lawn by the brook one morning, and a pair of muskrat.
