Early Royal Tour Recalled By Ancient Cannon Barrel

Thousands of citizens daily pass an interesting memento of the visit to Charlottetown of King Edward VII, then Prince of Wales in the summer of 1860. It is an old cannon barrel placed upright on the pavement at the corner of Queen and Grafton Streets. It is recorded that on the removal of the ordnance from the lockhouse in 1856, an 18-pounder gun was allowed to slip from a sling and roll over the bank of the fortress to the water's edge, where it remained for several years. In July 1860, when all were preparing for the reception of His

Royal Highness, Theophilus DesBrisay had the gun brought to Charlottetown and placed in its present position, with the muzzle upwards. A stout flag-staff of considerable length was placed in the bore of the gun, from the summit of which the Union Jack was displayed during the three days of the Prince's sojourn here. Though the staff has been removed for many years the gun remains erect, as a memento of the harbour's fortifications, and a memorial to one of Charlottetown's most joyful occasions.
