## Presbyterians Debate Role Of Women

TORONTO (CP)—The Presbyterian Church decided Tuesday it is not ready to accept women to its ruling eldership or ministry.

It did, however, reserve the right to ordain women to either of these posts subject to the approval of its 48 presbyteries and without the necessity of forming a doctrine on it.

Rev. Louis H. Fowler of Toronto, chairman of the committee on the place of women in the church, told the 82nd general assembly of the Presbyterian Church in Canada:

"On the basis of the replies we received from our presbyteries we feel we cannot yet recommend women for the ministry."

A preliminary survey showed that both men and women were against the ordination of women to official church posts.

**URGES FURTHER STUDY**  
The assembly heard Margaret McNaughton of Toronto, national Presbyterian girls' work secretary, ask for continued study of the matter.

"I do not want to underestimate the importance of the question of the ordination of women," she said, "but I feel there is a more important question, namely what is the place of all the women in the church...."

"Many women reach mature Christian insights at a time when they have the most to give, only to find that the church has no place for them."

"In an age when society is in flux the Christian woman looks to the church for a definition of her place—but even here she finds uncertainty and confusion."

## Reserve Decision In Appeal Case

HALIFAX (CP)—The Nova Scotia Supreme Court reserved decision Wednesday in an appeal of James P. Carleton, 40, a native of Saskatchewan, who was sentenced to a three-year prison sentence for fraud at Sydney May 8.

Carleton pleaded guilty to 10 charges of fraud. The Supreme Court recommended a psychiatric examination for him.

In his appeal Wednesday, Carleton said he thought the penitentiary sentence had been given on his past record. His record, read to the court, revealed a 10-year history of similar charges and convictions for fraud, which began in Vancouver in 1945.
