

**10 Remote Polls
Are Unreported
In Nfld. Riding**

GRAND FALLS, Nfld. (CP)— It may be weeks yet before the complete federal election vote from the huge Grand Falls White Bay-Labrador riding is complete, returning officer Joseph Yetman said here.

Only 10 of the riding's 292 polling districts are still outstanding, but all of them are on the isolated Labrador coast, stretching from Battle Harbor in the south to Cartwright at the mouth of Sandwich Bay.

Monday was declaration day, when returning officers in most ridings opened the ballot boxes to make an official count of the deputy returning officers tally sheets. This count will be postponed in Grand Falls-White Bay-Labrador.

It can be put off from week to week until all the ballot boxes arrive, Mr. Yetman said. "It may be the last of July before we are all cleaned up," he added.

However, the Labrador votes won't have any effect on the outcome of the election. Liberal incumbent Charles R. Granger has carried the seat with 18,004 votes, including the armed services vote, compared to Progressive Conservative Walford Nelson's 6,005 votes.

**Telephone Holds
Vital Position**

BASKATON (CP)— The telephone industry is playing a vital role in Canada's economy as a supplier of services, a builder of new plants and an employer, J. E. Richardson, president of the Telephone Association of Canada, said here.

Mr. Richardson, speaking at opening sessions of the association's 33rd annual meeting, said that almost \$250,000,000 in wages and salaries were paid by the telephone industry in 1961 to its 52,000 employees.

Mr. Richardson, president of the Maritime Telegraph and Telephone Company, Halifax, told delegates that Canada's major telephone organizations made capital expenditures of \$300,000,000 last year and will spend a similar amount this year.

More than 100 representatives of Canada's 10 major telephone systems are attending the meeting which continues until Friday.
