UPEI Theatre Society Holding General Meeting

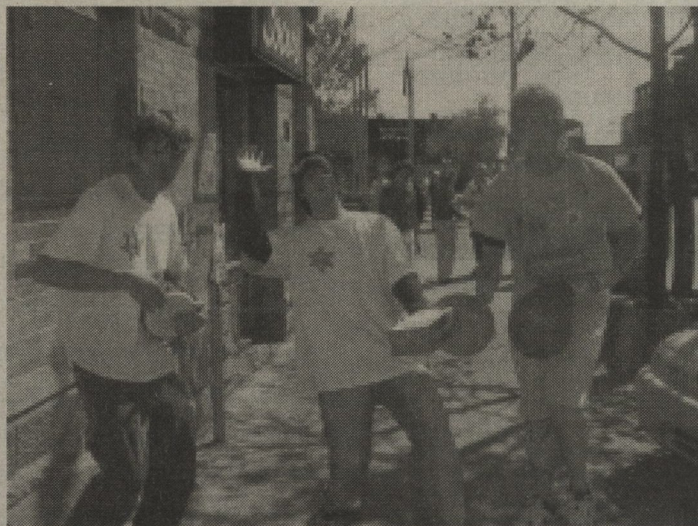

The chair of the National Shinerama Council is more than pleased with UPEI's success during this year's Shinerama fund-raiser. Drew Dudley said it is a rare thing for a school to double their donations in two years, and looks forward to our continued success.

"I couldn't be more thrilled with UPEI's recent Shinerama success. The work of Ryan McDermott, Shaun Coady and all of UPEI's volunteers has created a campaign that is not only a tribute to your school, but an example to other campaigns of what youth, energy and friendship can make possible. Very rarely has a school been able to double their Shinerama contribution in just two years - and I firmly believe we will continue to see UPEI's development as one of the country's most successful campaigns."
