

HUNTERS' CORNER

Native Partridge Come Back

One of the most encouraging features of the 1956 hunting season is the comeback of our Ruffed Grouse. For the past 15 years grouse hunting has been a sort of hit or miss venture. The birds were so scarce in comparison with the old days when almost any grouse hunter got for his walk was the exercise. In times past when the Southport Farmer and I took our annual upland game bird hunt it was nothing unusual to flush 15 or 20 'Natives' as we referred to them when we were younger. True there was a skeleton population in all three counties but it was not until last year (1955) they showed any noticeable increase in numbers, but they sure hit the high notes this season.

It was a favourable breeding season to begin with but I feel that our grouse were on the upswing. The Ruffed Grouse is often referred to by sportsmen as the King of upland game birds. It's swift of wing, beautifully plumaged and its flesh delicious. Most prefer the pheasant and consider the gaudy arrayed bing-neck is tops on a platter. Grouse are inclined to be dry unless basted frequently. Some cooks place strips of fat bacon over the breast during the roasting process. I never thought I'd see the day again when our grouse would be back in something like their old time numbers. Let's hope they continue their upward sweep.

PLENTY BUNNIES

Hunters who follow the beagies and rabbit hounds will have no dearth of targets this winter—the bunnies have hit an all time high so far as the younger generation of hunters is concerned. I have seen them more plentiful in the days when I first commenced testing a shotgun but the present day population is a close second. Back in the silver fox ranching days it was legal to feed rabbits to foxes. I remember one winter the late J. O. Jenkins sent a call to several merchants in the Selkirk and St. Charles districts of eastern Kings for some rabbits. I believe the price offered was 15 cents a pair. They started rolling in lots of one hundred and a few days and he was just beginning to roll. He was almost swamped with rabbits before he got word out to halt buying. Ten or 12 years ago rabbits practically disappeared from eastern Kings and foxes were blamed for

the kill off. About six years ago the bunnies started a comeback. It took them several years to get rolling and last year they were back in good numbers but the woods and swamps are teeming with them this season. Better take your innings boys while the going is good for methinks they have almost reached their cycle peak. The lowly rabbit is not to be sneezed at either in a stew, fricasee or pot-pie. They are really more filling than either grouse or pheasant and are not inclined to put too much fat on ones ribs. Those who have to watch their waistline need have no fear of eating rabbit.

MUSKRAT:
Just how far the present unseasonable drought will effect the muskrat take is problematical at the moment. Ponds and swamps that sported six or a dozen 'rat' houses this time last year are dry as the Sahara Desert at the moment. A muskrat house, if it is a large one and not a mere push-up, generally shelters from four to six occupants. Many had to seek places where water was abundant and stable during late summer and it would be natural to assume a heavy population would result in certain areas. It doesn't always work out that way. A muskrat is pretty helpless on dry land and foxes, coons, owls, ravens, etc. take a heavy toll.

A muskrat has sharper teeth and is a tough fighter if given half a chance. An observer at Black Pond in Kings County watched a fox and muskrat having a sparring match last spring. Brer Fox intercepted Mr. Muskrat while he was making his way across a strip of land to another section of the pond. It didn't last long. The fox circled his quarry making little dashes in and out with the muskrat meeting each one with bared teeth. It was over quickly. The fox saw his opening and a quick spring and snap and the fight was over—a knockout in the 4th round. The observer had no opportunity to intervene. The fox looked back once as he trotted off to the woods with the loser in his mouth. Incidentally the season on Muskrat, Mink and Beaver opens on November 10th—this Saturday. The Ruffed grouse season closed on October 31st. The Hun and pheasant season closes on the tenth—Saturday.

The season on Huns and pheasants ends on October 1st to November 11th. The eleven falls on a Sunday but it is unlawful to hunt on Sunday.

Ottawa Signs Clair For 5 Year Term

OTTAWA (CP)—Ottawa Rough Riders Thursday signed coach Frank Clair to a five-year contract extending until the end of 1961. President Sam Berger of the Big Four football club said Clair was signed for the long term "at a reasonable increase in salary satisfactory to both himself and the club." The club also re-signed assistant coach Bill Smyth for a similar five year period, also with a salary boost. "It didn't take long to settle the contract," Berger said. The new contract has been under discussion for about the last three weeks and was signed Thursday. Clair came here last January on a two-year contract and pulled Rough Riders by their boot straps into their first playoff position in five years. They were eliminated in a sudden-death semi-final Wednesday by Hamilton Tiger-Cats. "We're very well satisfied with his performance," Berger said. The five-year contract is believed for the longest term a coach ever has signed in Canadian professional football. Clair, 39, coached Toronto Argonauts five seasons in the 1950-54 period, winning two Grey Cups.
