# Manitoba Nickel Output Starts At 60 Million Lbs.

TORONTO (CP) — Initial production from the Northern Manitoba project of the International Nickel Company of Canada is expected to be at a rate of 60,000,000 pounds of nickel a year, Dr. John F. Thompson chairman of the company, said Wednesday.

Production from the \$175,000,000 development, announced in December 1956, is scheduled for 1960. Dr. Thompson said production would presumably advance to 75,000,000 pounds, and his report on nickel production to the annual meeting seemed to indicate a final move-up.

He and other officials said, however, that in such a large project, with possible unknown difficulties ahead, they did not wish to name definite dates.

ANNUAL MEETING  
Dr. Thompson gave the Manitoba nickel project in reply to a question at press conference held in connection with the annual meeting.

Previous announcements had said the Manitoba undertaking, together with expansion at Sudbury, Ont., would increase capacity by 100,000,000 pounds but did not say how much of this would come from Manitoba.

The project, located in the Mystery Lake and Moak Lake area, is 400 miles north of Winnipeg and will be connected by branch line to the Canadian National Railway line running from The Pas to Churchill, on Hudson Bay.

In 1956 the company produced 286,000,000 pounds of nickel out of a free-world production of 450,000,000 pounds, and the Manitoba

and Sudbury additions will bring its production to about 380,000,000 pounds out of a free-world production forecast at 650,000,000 to 675,000,000 pounds by 1961.

ATTRACT INDUSTRIES  
In his address to the annual meeting, Dr. Thompson said the Manitoba project, together with power development by the province's hydro-electric board, is expected to attract new industries—such as forest industries—to the northern area and have a broad impact on the province's whole economy. The port of Churchill might well develop a thriving two-way exchange of freight between Western Canada and the United Kingdom and continent.

In reply to a shareholder's question regarding the grade of Manitoba ore, Dr. Thompson said that "on the average, on a long-scale, we will mine ore of a higher grade but much higher than we have mined in the last few years at Copper Cliff (Sudbury)."

ASKS OF ROLLING MILL  
Another shareholder asked if there was any prospect of establishment of a rolling-mill in Canada.

Dr. Thompson said such operations go where a market exists for their output. He added,

"We look forward to the day when we will have a rolling mill in Canada. I don't know when that will be, but it will be the minute it is profitable to do so. At present it would operate at a loss. But the day for it keeps getting closer and closer."

The annual meeting approved a number of by-laws and re-elected retiring directors. One series of by-laws approved the changed capital stock position resulting from the wiping out of the company's preferred stock, which was called for redemption Feb. 1. The sum of \$34,742,000 had been set aside for this purpose in 1956.

Ownership of International Nickel's stock, it was stated, now is about 35-per-cent Canadian and from 40- to 45-per-cent American, with the balance held in Britain, the continent and other countries.

In numbers, Canadians form the largest group—more than 50 per cent—having grown from 24,000 some years ago to about 39,000. Stocks held by investment funds and organizations in the United States and Europe, however, probably represented a larger numerical holding than showed on the records.
