The Net Earnings at \$224,379 were \$9,558.28 higher than those of 1949. Taxes were \$15,000 higher at \$80,000. Dividends of 80 cents on each \$10 share were paid as usual.

During the year improvements and changes at the Halifax Office were made including modernizing of the main vault. A modern vault was installed at Lunenburg and after the usual write-off at all Branches for Depreciation the Office Premises Account stands at \$465,000.

Branches of the Company were opened in Calgary under the management of Mr. W. N. Grabum who was also designated as Supervisor for Western Canada and at Vancouver under the management of Mr. E. E. Spencer. Hon. Harold Connolly was appointed a Director of the Company.

The Operations and Records of the Company were subjected to the usual Examination by the Inspection Officials of the Dominion Government and other Jurisdictions and by the Inspection Committee of your Board. All items of the Company's Assets were examined by the Company's Inspection Staff and the Shareholders' Auditors and the Certificate of the latter is affixed to the Report.

During the year the Company suffered great losses in the deaths of Mr. Alexander J. Campbell, K.C. of Truro, a Director since 1916, and Mr. R. G. Beazley of Halifax, a Director since 1922. Both these gentlemen were assiduous in the performance of the duties which fell to them and both are much missed. Since 1945, Mr. Campbell had also been a Vice-President in which position his early training and experience in estate administration were greatly helpful. To fill the vacancy Mr. H. R. Silver, a Director since 1915, was appointed a Vice-President.

With the passage of time and the accumulating experience gained in administration by the Officers, the excellence of the services rendered by your Company to clients large and small becomes yearly more marked and the Company's services naturally are becoming in ever increasing demand.

Your Directors wish to express their appreciation of the loyal and efficient services the Members of the Staff have continued to render in the discharge of their duties.
