"The Halifax Pop Explosion was the prequel, Halifax On Music is the sequel." That is how Nova Scotia's new three day pop music extravaganza is being promoted. Pop Explosion organizer Peter Rowan has relocated to Ontario; the original festival is no more. However, this does not mean the end of showcasing all of the great bands Canada has to offer. Enter Halifax On Music (H.O.M.).

Organized by Colin MacKenzie (MURDERRecords, Cinnamon Toast Records), Angie Fenwick (Angie Fenwick Management) and Wayne Mason (No Records), H.O.M. will showcase over thirty-five bands and artists at three venues in Halifax from September 13-15.

Along with showcasing bands, there will also be the Rock and Roll Carnival and Halifax On Media which will feature acoustic performances and two pop culture performers. To attend H.O.M. as a full delegate, the cost is \$100 plus taxes. This pass gives you guaranteed entrance to all events including the Rock and Roll Carnival, Halifax On Media, the Cinnamon Toast Brunch and you will receive a Halifax On Music survival bag and an invitation to the "Halifax Off The Wagon" Cocktail Party.

A bar pass is a mere \$35 plus taxes--this gives admittance to the four bar shows plus the Sunday all ages

finale, as well as the Carnival and Halifax On Media. The all ages pass is even cheaper at \$19 plus taxes. It gives access to the Friday and Saturday all ages shows at Cafe Ole and the Sunday finale as well as the Carnival and, of course, Halifax On Media. Individual tickets are also available.
