Grain WINNIPEG, May 28 - (CP) - Closing prices of coarse grain futures generally showed a firm trend today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange with a considerable improvement in commercial demand over early trading. Commercial demand included both shipping and export purchases in oats and barley with some processor's demand in flax. Buying was stimulated by predictions of frost in the U.S. grain areas which might have an adverse effect on flax. A lack of moisture in the Canadian grain belt also was considered to have an effect on buying. No information was available on overnight loadings of wheat but 140,000 bushels of barley were reported sold to Norway. There were smaller sales of barley and oats to the continent.
