APPROPRIATIONS FOR ROADS, BRIDGES AND WHARFS.

QUEEN'S COUNTY (continued). DISTRICT No. 9. Comprising Townships Nos. 49 and 50. Repairs to road from Tea Hill to County line, Georgetown road, £20 0 0. Repairs to road from Uigg to head of Orwell (Fletcher's road), 4 0 0.

DISTRICT No. 10. Comprising Townships Nos. 57 and 58. Repairs to Surry road, east and west, £4 0 0. Repairing Newton road, east and west, 4 0 0. Repairing Douse's road, east and west, 4 0 0.

DISTRICT No. 11. Comprising Townships Nos. 60 and 62. Repairs to road from Flat River to south Eginette Wharf, 4 0 0. Post road and bridge from County line to Bell Creek, 9 0 0.

DISTRICT No. 12. Comprising Charlotte, Common and Royal, Poplar Island Bridge, and Township No. 32, North of York River. For repairs of Post roads where most required, £139 10 0.

DISTRICT No. 13. Comprising Township No. 65, south side of Elliot River. Road from Koderick MacKinnon's to Ferguson's creek, £4 0 0.

KING'S COUNTY.

DISTRICT No. 1. Comprising Townships Nos. 38, 39 and 40, West of Morell River. From County line to Morell bridge, £20 0 0. To build a new bridge or repair the old one near McEwen's mill, 6 0 0.

DISTRICT No. 2. Comprising Townships Nos. 41, 40 and 39, East of Morell River and St. Peter's Harbor Mouth. Main Post road from Morell to head of St. Peter's Bay, £35 0 0.

DISTRICT No. 3. Comprising Townships Nos. 42 and 43, and line road, between Townships Nos. 43 and 44. To repair line road between Lots 43 and 44, £16 0 0.

DISTRICT No. 4. Comprising Townships Nos. 44 and 45. Due William McCabe for repairing Grant's road, £2 5 0. Due Lawrence McDonald for repairing hill at Angus McEwen's, 3 0 0.

DISTRICT No. 5. Comprising Townships Nos. 46 and 47. Due Angus B. Campbell for work on Baltic road, £1 0 0. Due Andrew McEwen for work on Priest Pond bridge, 0 10 0.

roads and bridges from Rose's Mill bridge to Anderson, 3 0 0. Murrays' bridge across the Lake, 2 0 0. Road, &c., from Anderson's to East Lake bridge, 3 0 0.

DISTRICT No. 6. Comprising Townships Nos. 55, and 56, North of Grand River. Due Robert Howlett for labor, 1863, on Grand River Wharf, £2 16 0. Due John Morrow for labor on Grand River Wharf, 1 5 0.

DISTRICT No. 7. Comprising Townships Nos. 55, South of Grand River, 53, North of Grand River, and 54. Due Farquhar Campbell for repairs to Cardigan House, 1863, 8 0 0.

DISTRICT No. 8. Comprising Township No. 55, South of Brudenell River, and Townships Nos. 51, 52 and 53. Due Charles Alley for repairing bridge at Beatons' mill, 1863, £0 5 0.

DISTRICT No. 9. Comprising Townships Nos. 59 and 61, and Montague Bridge. Montague bridge, £45 0 0. To repair road from Ball creek to Priest Pond bridge, 1 10 0.

Bridge on the Wood Island road, 12 0 0. Where most required in District, 12 7 3. Unexpended appropriations of last year, where most required, £186 7 3.

DISTRICT No. 10. Comprising Townships Nos. 63 and 64. Road from Graham's to Sentiner's, £8 0 0. Mink River road, from James Clow's to Sentiner's, 6 0 0.

DISTRICT No. 11. Comprising Georgetown, Common and Royal, and several lands adjoining thereto, and that part of Township No. 53, between Cardigan and Brudenell Rivers. Due Donald McAlroy for keeping post road in repair from McAlroy's road to M'Connell's field, for the year ending 1st July, 1864, £3 10 0.
