Financial Aid

As I promised last week, this column is aimed at students who are interested in graduate studies for September, 1986. As we all know, graduate studies mean money and money means getting busy and applying for scholarships, bursaries, fellowships and grants early. Now that I have made the point that we must do things early I'll get on with it.

A few tips in aiding you in your search for the big bucks area: 1. Write to universities you are interested in and ask about their financial aid services to graduate students 2. Check bulletin boards around campus for notices of awards, especially in the department you are interested in. Talk to the chairmen of departments who may have information about the fields you are interested in 3. Check the financial aid files in the Department of Student Services and/or consult with the financial aid advisor as to what is available.

Many of the deadlines for graduate studies are in the fall for the following year's study, so get on the ball early and don't miss out.
