NEW YORK, Sept. 1—(AP)—A leading producer boosted the price of refined copper 1-4 cent today to 19 3-4 cents a pound, the highest since April.  
The advance came after insistent demand through the day had influenced several sellers to withdraw at the 10 1-2 cent level.

WINNIPEG, Aug. 31—(CP)—Five-cent allowance limit leaps when wheat futures prices made when operations opened on Winnipeg grain exchange today were held throughout the session. Values closed at their starting levels, with October posting a final price of 64, November 65 3-8, December 65 1-2 and May 68 1-2 cents.  
War news from eastern Europe brought a buying rush as soon as trading was resumed and within a few seconds quotations had jumped the permissible limit. Following the opening spurge, operations slowed practically to a standstill as values clung easily to the top levels.  
All coarse grain prices soared the five-cent limit in hectic trading.  
Excellent buying advanced Liverpool values 1 1-2-1 1-4 while United States wheat futures prices hiked their limits in all deferred positions.

CHICAGO, Sept. 1—(AP)—Grain prices soared as high as they could under trading rules today as the outbreak of fighting in Europe stunned the financial district. Wheat prices jumped 5 to 8 cents a bushel, corn 4 to 5 cents, oats 3 to 6 cents and rye 5 to 8 cents.  
Closing prices for practically every grain contract quoted on the exchange were at the pegged limits for the session. Wheat was 5 to 8 cents net higher, Sept. 75 7-8, Dec. 73 1-2 and May 74 1-8. Corn closed 4 to 6 1-4 cents up, Sept. 50-49 3-4, Dec. 48 1-8; oats 3 to 4 5-8 higher.
