CAUGHT BY AN OCTOPUS

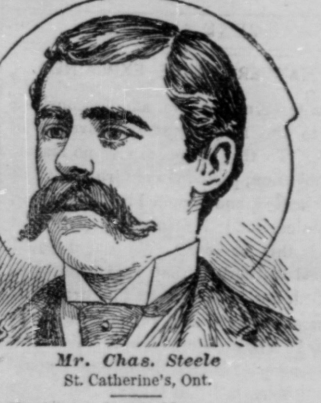
