## Liberal Mag Has Gov't Aid By Constituencies

OTTAWA (CP)—One of the big problems facing candidates in a federal election is the need for information—facts and figures about government operation, their party's policies and current issues.  
All parties try to meet this demand, and with an election approaching the Liberal party is first in print with a publication which may well be the main handbook of its candidates across the country.

It is a magazine called *The Canadian Liberal*, published every three months. It normally deals with speeches by Prime Minister St. Laurent and other cabinet ministers. The current 150-page issue just off the press is no exception in that.

But it also packs in to 30 pages figures which are almost certain to be frequently used on the hustings by Liberal candidates.

**LOCAL APPEAL**  
They are a listing, for each of the country's 263 constituencies, of federal expenditures on family allowances, on the \$40 monthly pensions for all those 70 and over, and on the old age assistance for needy persons between 65 and 69 for which Ottawa contributes up to 20 a month.

It estimates the amounts paid in each riding since the inception of the three plans and during the 1955-56 fiscal year ended last March 31, and also the number receiving the payments.

The riding-by-riding figures are not exact totals. No government statistics are kept on payments by constituencies. However, the magazine has taken the total payments in each province and prorated them according to each riding's share of the population of children and old age pensions are the same throughout the province.

**HELPFUL HINTS**  
Headquarters staff of the other parties are working to produce literature they hope will be useful to their own candidates.

The Progressive Conservatives have a Speaker's Handbook in preparation which they hope to produce about the end of March. It is aimed at providing a digest of party policy for the guidance of candidates and other workers who will be making stump speeches. The handbook for the 1953 election had 136 pages and was marked "confidential" although it had a wide distribution.

The CCF party also is working on a booklet which will combine policy information, facts and figures with a few tips to candidates on the preparation of press releases and delivery of radio speeches.

## GP's Told New Methods To Check Bleeding

MONTREAL (CP)—Doctors attending the first scientific meeting of the College of General Practice of Canada were told Monday of newly developed methods for checking what formerly was often fatal bleeding.  
Dr. Paul Well reported on methods used at Royal Victoria Hospital, Montreal, in preserving substances in the blood bank. The substances can be separated from whole blood and given by transfusion to patients whose blood does not clot.  
Dr. Well said certain kinds of hemorrhage—particularly bleeding in children—now can be controlled.

## British Columbia Plans Centennial Celebration

VANCOUVER (CP)—British Columbia will cast off its habitual reserve to celebrate all through 1958 the centenary of the province behind the mountains.

The year-round party, planned to let the rest of the world know what's going on in Canada's "far west," is expected to cost \$5,000,000.

"And we'll do our best to get everybody else to celebrate with us," says Larry McCance, 40-year-old executive secretary of the B.C. Centennial Committee.

McCance, born and educated in B.C., became a noted writer-actor of stage and radio in Eastern Canada before taking on the job of directing the province-wide celebrations.

**FRIENDLY WELCOMES**  
"The people of B.C., like alpine dwellers in other countries, are traditionally quiet and reserved. Some call us unfriendly, but that isn't so," said McCance, explaining how the gala celebration is being planned.

"We hope to throw the biggest party of its kind ever conducted in North America. The whole world is invited."

There'll be major winter sport spectacles, ice and snow carnivals; spring blossom festivals and Indian pow-wows; summer regattas, loggers' sports, outdoor pageants and fishing derbies; fall fairs, rodeos, more pageants and more sports.

Since the centennial committee was established by an act of the legislature last year, these projects already are ahead of the planning stage.

The 1958 Grey Cup game, to be played in Vancouver.

The \$50,000 Centennial Golf Open, a major attraction on the gold trail of professional golf, to be staged here in September, probably Labor Day weekend.

A gala outdoor pageant and ceremony Nov. 19 at retired Fort Langley on the Fraser River where 100 years ago Governor Douglas declared the birth of B.C. Princess Margaret, along with other world-known people, has been invited to attend.

Scores of other big projects are still in the idea stage or early planning by the centennial board of directors and its 350-man organization. At the same time, more than 200 sub-committees throughout the province are organizing their own community projects.

One such project is a series of outdoor pageants to revive David Thompson's historic canoe trip down the river which bears his name. The famed explorer actually made the trip 100 years ago this summer but the celebration of its anniversary has been postponed to the centenary.
