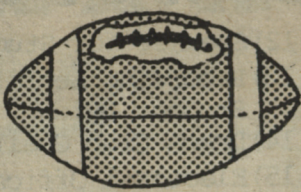

ever break through.

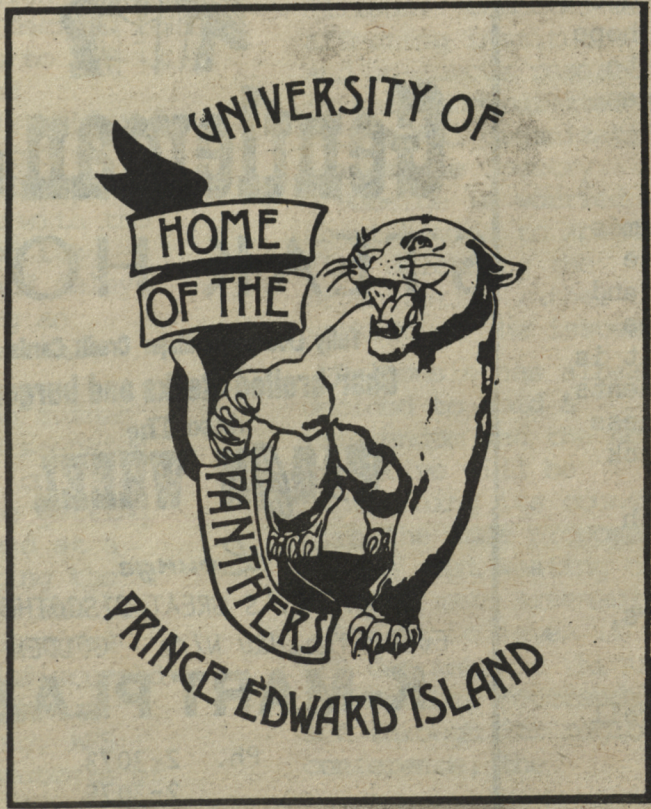
Equally unexpected was the poor start that our golf team got off to in the first round of the AUSA championships. As you may recall I predicted that we would win the title.
