

Possibility Britain May Return To Olympic Hockey

LONDON (CP)—Britain, once a power on European hockey rinks, may return to the international ice wars in 1958. Britain did not enter a hockey team in the recent winter Olympics, won by Russia.

The key to revived British interest in international hockey is a proposal that the world and European hockey championships be run off as separate competitions instead of together as at present.

The proposal, brainchild of J.F. Bunney Ahearne, European president of the International Ice Hockey Federation, will be submitted to federation members at the world championships in Moscow next year. If accepted, it would go into operation in 1958.

REMOVE TOP TEAMS

"We have reached the stage where something must be done to give the weaker hockey countries something to aim at," says Ahearne, head of a London travel agency.

Under his plan the top four European countries in the 1957 championships at Moscow would be elected to play against Canada and the United States for the 1958 world title.

The remaining teams would be eligible for the European championships.

"The idea is to allow only the strongest European teams to compete for the world title and to leave the European title for teams with a lower standard of play," says Ahearne.

"In this way we would have a better world tournament and at the same time the European competition would attract teams from countries like Britain, Holland, Belgium and Norway that now feel the world competition is too much for them."

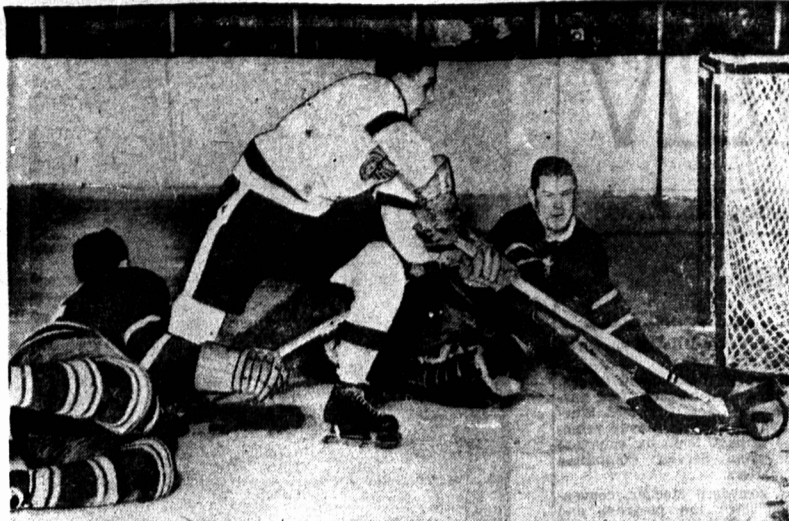

Wes Santee Was Turning In High Expense Sheet

SAN FRANCISCO (AP)—Miller Wes Santee, barred from further amateur competition by the national AAU, was turning in daily expenses ranging from \$25 to \$38.50 while competing in west coast meets last spring, it was learned Friday.

"He explained to us that he had to be a 'good guy' and told us that he had to pick up the tab many times," said Carl Hansen of Oakland, National AAU president.

Hansen, who conducted the hearings in New York which led to Santee's lifetime disbarment, added that the former University of Kansas distance star's wife had "expenses" which amounted to \$1,158 last year.

The AAU forbids athletes from collecting expense money for their families and has a \$15 top daily expense of competitors.

"We gave Santee every opportunity to clear himself and he couldn't," said Hansen. "All of us are sorry about what happened to him but any time anyone tells me that a 23-year-old man, and a college graduate and a Marine at that, doesn't know what he's doing, I refuse to listen."

Santee, now on active duty with the Marines at Quantico, Va., said he planned to keep in shape "because I feel certain the AAU will see the light." He added that he hoped to be able to represent the United States in the Olympic Games next fall and "try once again to beat four minutes."
