## Newfoundland renaissance

### NEWFOUNDLAND RENAISSANCE

It seems the destruction of the "outports" over the past years on the cold gray rock they call Newfoundland has created a renaissance in Newfie art and culture. This summer saw the premiere of the musical version of Gordon Pinsent's ROWDY-MAN at the Charlottetown Festival last year in Philadelphia to help mark the American Bicentennial. (CODCO makes a return engagement to the Centre on Oct 22 at 8:00 p.m.) Now there is Gerry Squires and Frank Lapointe. The exhibition by this duo of talented artists will run in Confederation Centre Art Gallery and Museum from October 12 until Oct 31.

Gerry Squires' THE BOATMAN: A RELENTLESS JOURNEY is both a personal

and a mythical odyssey into his own individual darkness and reality. In painting after painting, the image of the boatman challenging the sea is apparent. It is the challenge of man against nature, but more importantly, man against himself. It is an exhibition at once strikingly brilliant and deeply intriguing. Without a doubt, Squires is one of the most important painters to emerge from Newfoundland in years.

Frank Lapointe's POSTCARD SERIES contains fourteen lithographs of old Newfoundland picture postcards. He aims to show one aspect of Newfoundland lifestyle through the simple means of the postcard. Both the photos and the messages they contain on the back are exhibited. The honest human quality of the postcard is certainly one of the aspects that makes this exhibition so appealing.

Both of these exhibitions should not be missed as they contain them so much a part of the personality and character of the Maritimes. The ART Gallery is open Tuesday to Saturday from 10:00 a.m. until 5:00p..m. and Sunday from 2 to 5 p.m. Admission is by donation.
