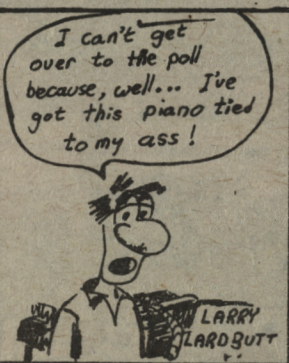
Grindstone Island Peace School
