Can Detain One Without A Trial

NICOSIA, Cyprus (Reuters)—Un- easy Cypriots Monday observed the second anniversary of a law which permits the British government to detain anyone without trial.

The 1,000 detainees, including 24 women, went on a 24-hour hunger strike to protest their continued imprisonment in what they call concentration camps.

The British colonial administration put the law into effect in 1955 in an effort to stamp out the activities of EOKA, the underground organization pledged to drive out the British by force.

Several hundred Cypriot youths Monday staged a demonstration against the law. It was the first major demonstration since EOKA called a truce four months ago. The demonstrators were dispersed by British troops equipped with bayonets and fire hoses.

UNION WITH GREECE
Greek Cypriots want the Mediterranean island politically joined with Greece, Turkish Cypriots, who are outnumbered 4 1/2 to 1, oppose the move.

"It is time the curtain fell on the tragedy of 1,000 Cypriots who are kept away from their families, who suffer myriad hardships with- out even being told what they have done or why they are detained and without being given a chance to defend themselves in a court of law," said the newspaper Alitheia.

The government has detained nearly 1,500 under the law but about 500 have been released. The detainees include policemen, students, lawyers, teachers, and housewives.

Fadil Kutchuk, a Turkish Cypriot leader, said in an article in his own newspaper, Halkin Sesi, that self-determination for the island as desired by exiled Cypriot Archbishop Makarios of the Greek Orthodox Church, "will definitely mean civil war in Cyprus."
