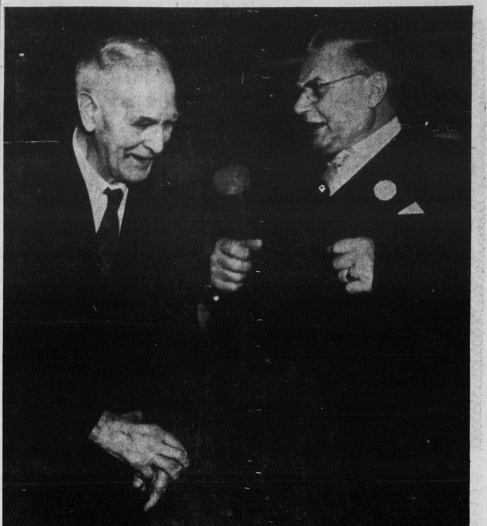


North Bedeque Crash Claims Fourth Victim
