The British Trades Union Congress will hold its next session in Glasgow in 1892. The Jewish Colonization Association has been registered in London; capital, £2,000,000 in £100 shares. Forty head of diseased cattle were found in a consignment which a few days ago arrived at New York from England per steamer Selvo.

The Columbian of the 3rd says that all the salmon canneries are shut down, and the hands have been paid off. Notwithstanding the smallness of the pack, the amount paid out to the employes this year is almost as large as usual.

THE QUEBEC FIRE.—The big fire in Quebec on Sunday was in that section of the city known as Cape Blanc, which lies between St. Lawrence and the Cliffs just west of Cape Diamond harbor. Seventy-five families were rendered homeless.

WONDERFUL ENDURANCE.—At Beacon Park, Boston, on Saturday, a horse owned by Malcolm Thomas trotted 50 miles in four hours and thirty-seven minutes. The trotting was the outcome of a wager of \$1000 to \$200, that the horse could not trot 50 miles in five hours. The first mile was made in five minutes, and each succeeding mile was covered very close to the same time.

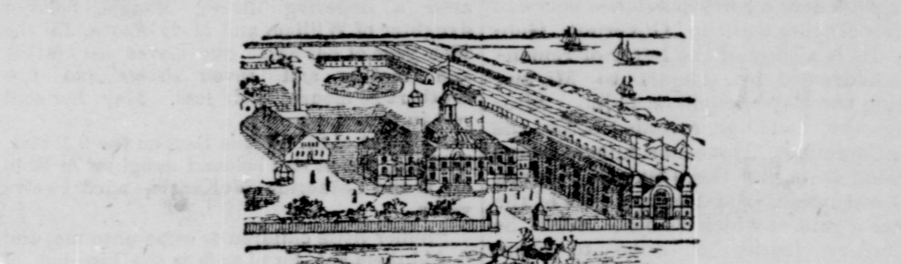
