Britain's Soldier Sons

How the New Armies Are Being Put Into Uniform.

July 1st, the date when the first of Britain's 200,000 militiamen are to be called up for Army service, will mark a milestone in British industrial expansion.

Woolen mills in the next twelve months the factories of Great Britain will be called on to clothe not only the 200,000 extra Territorials.
