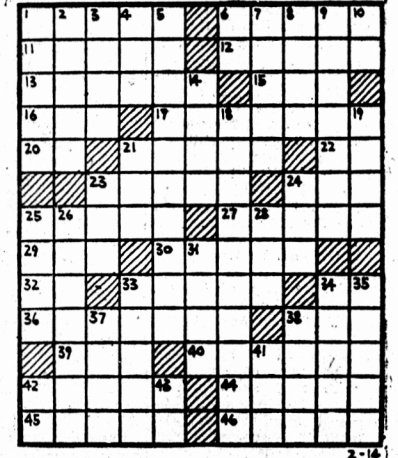

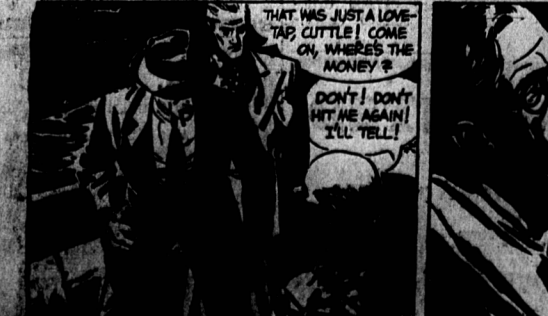

THE VITAL SELECTION PROCESS

The crucial problem in the following hand was to select the best plan of play from several possibilities.

South dealer.

North-South vulnerable.

♠ K J 8
♥ A Q J 10
♦ A 9 8 6
♣ A Q

♠ 7 6 3 2
♥ 7 1
♦ K 10 7 6
♣ 4 2

♠ A Q 10 9 5
♥ K 8
♦ K J 7 4
♣ 5 3

The bidding:

South	West	North	East
1♠	Pass	3♥	Pass
3♦	Pass	4NT	Pass
5♠	Pass	5NT	Pass
6♥	Pass	7♣ (final bid)	

North a good player, realized that his own grand-slam bid was not entirely safe, but he hoped that one of South's two announced kings would be in hearts, solidifying the suit, and that South would turn up with either a six-card spade suit or the K-Q of diamonds. Perhaps North should have been satisfied with a vulnerable small slam!

A club lead would have spiked South's guns by forcing him to take either the club or the diamond finesse, both of which were wrong; but West for some reason chose to open a heart. This lead gave South a splendid chance—but he went wrong. Winning with the heart king, he drew trumps, discarding a diamond from the board, then, after cashing the ace and king of diamonds in a futile effort to drop the queen, he had to fall back on the club finesse which of course let him down.

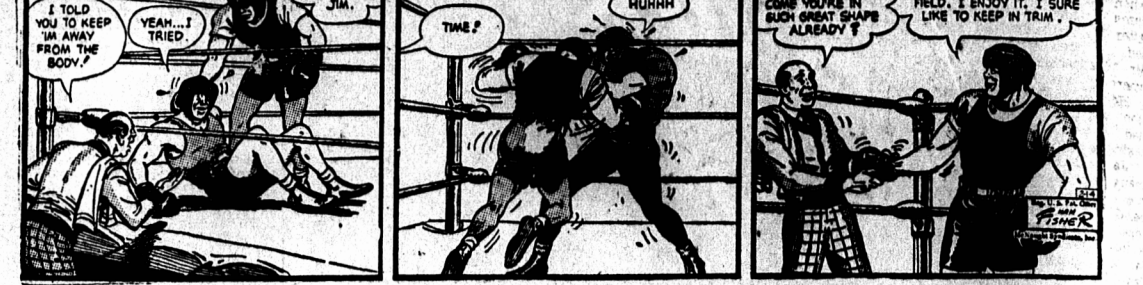
