TORONTO (CP) - All stocks and commodities markets in Canada will be closed Monday, Dominion Day.

Toronto Stocks

TORONTO (CP) - A general buying wave swept through the stock market Friday and gave it its first upward trend of the week. All sections but western oils made solid advances.

Senior base metals were paced higher by International Nickel and Hudson Bay, each up two points. Falconbridge was up 1/4 but Consolidated Smelters and Quemet dipped 1/4. Steeprock lost 1/4.

Belcher, which advanced 44 cents two days ago, added another 25-cent gain Friday to a new high of \$3.50. Little Long Lac, a winner of \$1.30 in the two previous sessions, lost 20 cents. Thompson Mining and Smelting and Beaucaug gained 15 cents. Consolidated Mac advanced 25 cents in western oils. Triad lost 20 cents, Canadian Atlantic 15 and Canadian Oil Lands 10 cents.

Index changes: Golds up 22 to 85.44; base metals up 37 to 237.85; western oils off 47 to 152.79.
