

Island Train Schedules Changed

MONCTON, N. B. — Commencing Monday, May 16th, changes will be made in Canadian National Railways train services between Charlottetown and Souris, Elmira and Souris, and Moun Stewart Jet. and Georgetown.

Train now leaving Souris for Charlottetown at 7.30 a.m. daily except Sunday will arrive Charlottetown at 11.00 a.m. instead of at 10.20 a.m. as at present.

Train now leaving Charlottetown for Souris at 2.30 p.m. daily except Sunday will arrive Souris on Thursdays at 6.30 p.m. instead of 5.30 p.m. as at present.

Train now leaving Souris for Elmira at 5.45 p.m. will be operated on Tuesday only. Instead of Tuesday and Thursday.

Train now leaving Souris at 6.45 p.m. will be operated on Monday only, instead of Monday and Friday.

Train now leaving Souris for Charlottetown and Georgetown, train now leaving Charlottetown at 2.30 p.m. daily except Sunday will leave Mount Stewart Jet. for Georgetown on Thursdays at 4.00 p.m. instead of 3.45 p.m. as at present.

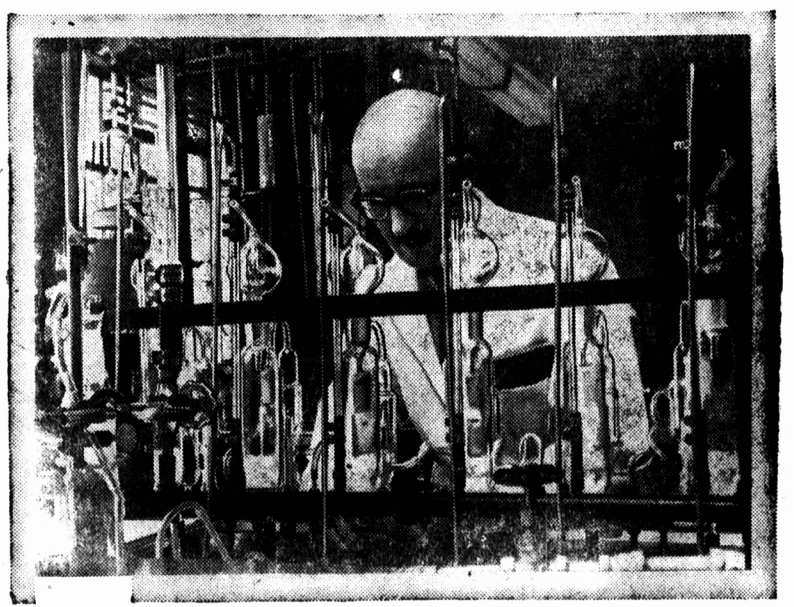
