TORONTO (CP) - The stock market drifted lower today in a dull session that saw a wide range of small losses. Trading was slowest since April of 1958.

Gold managed a few decimal points gain while base metals, thoroughly mixed, were off almost one-quarter.

H. G. Young, up 9 cents at \$1.18, had the best move among speculators. Three of the five most active gained.

Steel Company of Canada, trading ex-dividend, slipped 2 1/2 at 79. In base metals Hudson Bay was off 1/4 at 51 and Consolidated Mining gave up 1/4 at 17 1/2. Labrador added 1/4 at 28 while Fairchild gained 1/4 at 20 1/2. Consolidated Denison lost 1/4 at 12.

Hollinger led golds, up 1/4 at 30 1/2. Dome was ahead 1/4 at 18 1/2. Giant Yellowknife dipped 40 cents at \$9.30.

Seniors were off among western oils. Hudson's Bay eased 1/4 at 12 1/2 while Calgary and Edmonton and Pacific Pete gave up 1/4.
