My name is Joan Masterson and I am running for the position of Vice President Finance of the Student Union Executive.

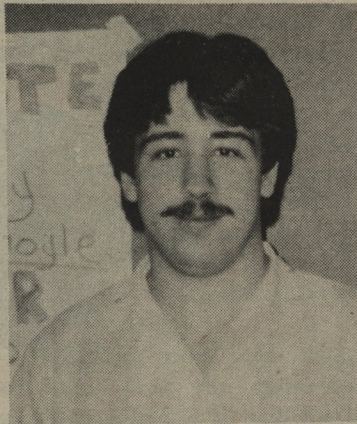
