"I want to be a pilot, more than anything in the world," he said, "and I've only had ten grades in school. When I'm eighteen, next year, I can get by with eleven grades, but it looks like I need another year at school, anyway."

"Well," I smiled, "you seem bright enough to manage it." "Oh, I suppose I can do it, all right," he said, "but it takes money, you know. The folks might get along without my earnings, but they certainly can't pay my way through school."

"Suppose you were ill," I said, "and had to have a long and expensive course of treatments. Is there any relative or family friend you could go to?" He looked up. "I bet Uncle Joe would be willing to take a chance on me and loan me the money. If I worked hard in the summer, and part time, I think I could make it. I'll have to convince him I mean business.
