Cook's Corner

RHUBARB AND STRAWBERRY PIE

1 1/2 cups rhubarb, cut in 1/2-inch pieces, 1 1/2 tablespoons flour, 1 1/2 cups strawberries, 1 cup sugar, few grains salt. Cover the bottom of an unbaked pie shell with the mixed rhubarb and strawberries. Combine the flour, sugar, and salt and sprinkle a layer over the rhubarb and strawberries. Continue until the pie shell is full. Put the top crust on and seal edges firmly. Bake in a hot oven 450 degrees F., for 10 minutes. Reduce heat to moderate 350 degrees F., and bake about 15 minutes longer.

PARTY PUNCH

6 tablespoons granulated sugar 6 tablespoons lemon juice 1/3 cup syrup from maraschino cherries 2 (12 ounce) cans apricot whole fruit nectar 1 (4/5 quart) bottle claret wine 1 (4/5 quart) bottle muscatel wine 1 (12-ounce) bottle sparkling water. Stir sugar, lemon juice and cherry syrup together until sugar dissolves. Add nectar and chill thoroughly. Chill wines and sparkling water about 4 hours. Pour chilled nectar mixture and wines over ice block in chilled punch bowl. Stir until blended and add sparkling water. Garnish with maraschino cherries and thin quartered orange slices. Makes about 40 servings (1/3 cup each).

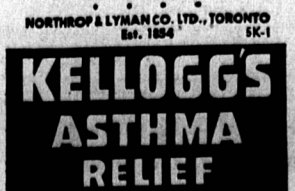

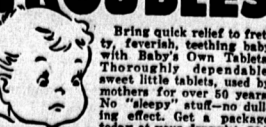

GINGER CUP PUDDINGS

Mix and sift twice, then sift into a bowl, 1 1/2 c. unsifted cake flour, 2 1/4 tsp. Magic Baking Powder, 1/4 tsp. salt, 1/4 tsp. ground ginger, 1/4 tsp. ground cinnamon, 1/4 tsp. each of ground cloves and ground nutmeg. Cut in finely 5 lbs. chilled shortening and mix in 1/2 c. lightly-packed brown sugar. Combine 1 well-beaten egg, 1/4 c. corn syrup and 1/4 c. milk. Make a well in dry ingredients and add liquid; mix lightly with a fork. Two-thirds fill greased cup-cake dishes with batter. Bake in moderate oven, 350°, about 25 minutes, or cover each pudding with wet cooking parchment paper, tie down and steam for 25 minutes. Serve hot with vanilla sauce. Yield - 5 servings.
