SYDNEY, N.S., Feb. 15 — (CP) — Sydney Millionaires have protested the addition of Paul Saindon to the lineup of Charlottetown Islanders, Harry McCann of the club executive reported tonight.

Saindon left Providence of the American Hockey League and joined Valleyfield Braves of the Quebec Senior group. George Dudley, secretary-manager of the C.A.H.A., said earlier that if Saindon played with Valleyfield after Feb. 1 he would be ineligible for the Maritime loop.
