

Canada Nearing Butter Shortage

OTTAWA (CP)—Canada will face a critical butter shortage by next spring unless stocks are imported, soon, an agriculture department spokesman said here.

Diminishing of butter stocks will continue until after Christmas. Without imports, stocks will drop to less than a two-week supply by April 1.

Canadians use about 1,000,000 pounds of butter a day. Estimated stocks under present consumption would be less than 15,000,000 pounds by April 1, and marketing channels alone need 20,000,000 pounds in circulation.

If current price trends are to be maintained additional supplies will be essential, the spokesman added.

A drop in Canada's milk production and diversion of more available milk supplies into other products, such as cheese, was blamed for the butter shortage.

This year is the third in a row that consumption has outpaced production. Canadians will use an estimated 350,000,000 pounds this year and production will reach 335,000,000 pounds.
