Loses Appeal In Attempted Murder

VANCOUVER (CP) — Marcel Frenette, 28, of Montreal, was dragged kicking and shouting from British Columbia Court of Appeal Monday after his plea against a 20-year attempted murder sentence was rejected.

Frenette and four others were convicted in the beating last June of Thomas Kinna. As Mr. Justice Sidney Smith rejected his appeals, Frenette asked if he could speak. He could not, the prisoner stepped forward and called:

"This is not a court. It's a kangaroo court. This is a frameup from beginning to end."

He was still struggling as RCMP dragged him from the room.

CONTRACT BRIDGE

South dealer. Both sides vulnerable. 10 6 K 6 3 10 8 5 3 A Q 10 9 8 7 6 5 4 3 2 A Q 7 6 5 4 3 2 A 7 6 2 7 5

The bidding: South West North East 1NT Pass 3NT Pass

Opening lead—five of spades. The raise to three notrump by the responder over partner's opening one notrump represents a hand suitable for notrump play containing 10 to 14 points.

North's three notrump bid was the proper response, even though he had only nine high card points.

Additional weight must be given to the good five card suit he has, as well as the sprinkling of intermediate cards.

East won the opening spade with the ace, and continued with the queen of spades. South perceived the queen to hold the trick in order to disrupt the opponents' communications, but was forced to win the third round of spades.

After running the club suit South

knocked out the ace of diamonds, and wound up making four notrump. We think South would have been defeated if East had played the queen instead of the ace of spades on the opening lead. It would have taken a great deal of courage and imagination by the declarer to have refused to win the queen of spades. He would have every reason to fear that the ace was in West's hand, and that a continuation of spades by East would wreck the hand.

From East's viewpoint, the queen was a sound play for two reasons. If West had the king, the queen would hold the trick as effectively as the ace, but if South had the king and could be persuaded to take it, a line of communication with West would be open to cash all his spade tricks later. East is in a position to know that his partner cannot have an entry aside from spades. He is looking at 12 high card points in his own hand and 9 in dummy. Even if he credits declarer with just a minimum notrump bid of 16 points, West will have only 3 points, one of which is bound to be the jack if it is not the king. The best defense, therefore, is for East to try to sell declarer the idea that West has the ace of spades, and hope to induce South to win the queen. If South does, he is defeated.

C.N.R. To Dieselize Montreal-Toronto Run

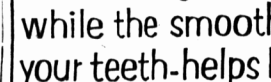
MONTREAL (CP) — Canadian National Railway announced Monday that it will dieselize the Montreal-Toronto runs of the International Limited and other name trains early next year.

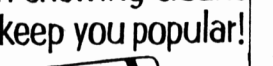

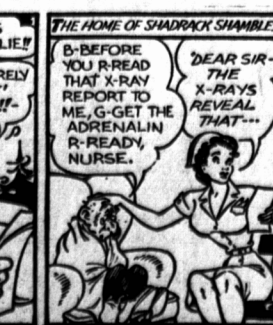
