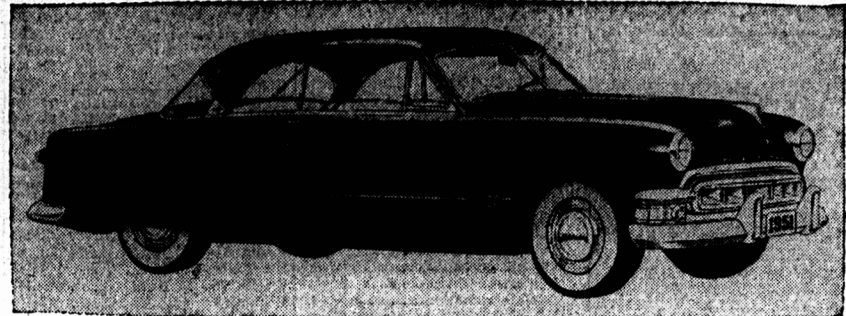

Be 17 to 40 (Tradesmen to 45); 4. Meet Army requirements; 5. Married men will be accepted. <p>TERMS OF ENGAGEMENT:</p> <p>You will be enrolled in the Canadian Army Active Force for a period of three years.</p> <p>All men are eligible for Overseas Service. If the military situation permits, married men after one year's Service Overseas, single men after two years' Service Overseas, may request discharge even if they have not completed full three years' service.</p>	<p>CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:</p> <p>Current rates of pay and allowances: Serve for 3 years or make it a career.</p> <p>VETERANS' BENEFITS:</p> <p>Reinstatement in civil employment, Unemployment Insurance and other appropriate benefits under Veterans' Charter as extended by Parliament.</p> <p>MEN:</p> <p>Retention of present Reserve Force rank or the rank held in Second World War, subject to proving qualifications in service within a 90-day period.</p> <p>OFFICERS:</p> <p>Short Service Commissions will be granted to officers who do not wish to enroll in the Active Force on a Career basis.
