Ontario Opposes Tolls Increase

TORONTO (CP) — Ontario went on record here in opposition to higher St. Lawrence Seaway tolls or tolls on the Welland Canal.

Premier Robarts, in a statement in the Ontario legislature, said the time has come for a reappraisal of the benefits of the entire Great Lakes system and its respective costs and revenues to the United States and Canada.

Mr. Robarts said his government made a submission to the St. Lawrence Seaway Authority Tuesday asking for a 90-day period during which the province could analyse what impact proposals made at current toll hearings would have on the Ontario economy.

Nigeria Told All Parties Abolished

LAGOS (Reuters) — Nigeria's military rulers have abolished all political parties in the country, the head of the federal military government announced in a nationwide broadcast.

Maj. Gen. Johnson Aguiyi-Ironi said the measures were aimed at forging national unity and were decided on during a week-long meeting here of the central executive council.

In addition to political parties, tribal unions and regionalism — also have been abolished, the general announced.

Aguiyi-Ironi assumed power after a bloody military coup on Jan. 16 in which the federal prime minister, Sir Abubakar Tafawa Balewa, and two regional premiers died.

Aguiyi-Ironi then suspended regional governments and the premiership — a 2-year presidency, announcing a two-year reorganization of the country. A return to civilian rule at an unspecified date was promised.
