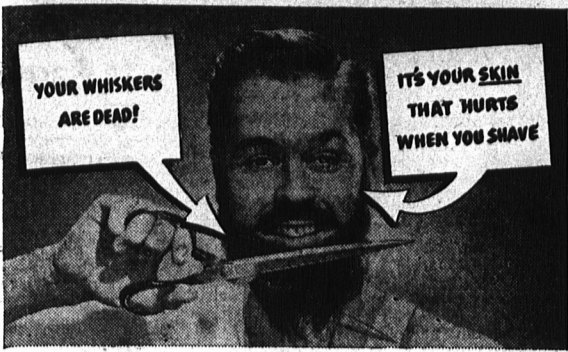


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Mrs. Haslam Re-elected To Head Ladies Golf Club
