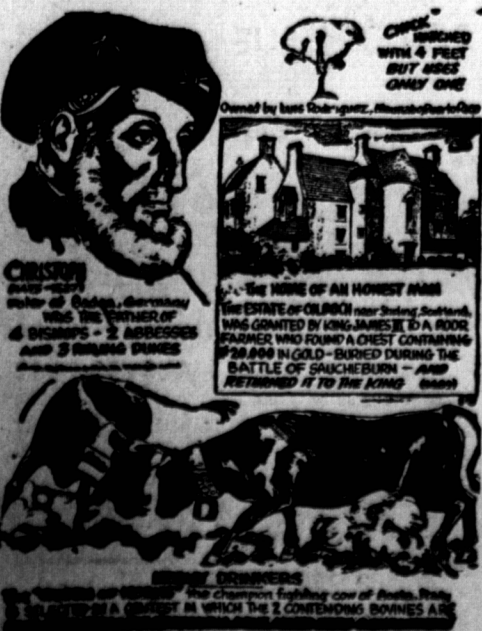

"Full Employment" Policy

Desirable, But Difficult

One of the results of the Second World War was to make depressions "socially unacceptable."
