

\$266 Million Nuclear Power Station Planned in Ontario

OTTAWA (CP)—Industry Minister Drury has confirmed in the Commons that a \$266,000,000 nuclear power station will be built in Ontario.

He said that Ontario Hydro will bear \$120,000,000 of the cost, the federal government \$95,000,000 and the Ontario government \$50,000,000.

The station is expected to be located east of Toronto. It will generate 1,000,000 kilowatts.

"If all goes as planned, base load nuclear power will be generated from coal-burning stations in the Ontario hydro system," said Mr. Drury.

Gordon Churchill, former Conservative trade minister, said Canada's 20-year-old nuclear program has been a major success. The scientists of Atomic Energy of Canada Limited

Carryover In Wheat Reduced

OTTAWA (CP)—Canada began its new crop Aug. 1 with a wheat carryover estimated at 401,577,000 bushels, the Dominion Bureau of Statistics said here.

The stockpile is about 35,570,000 bushels less than last year's revised estimate of 487,547,000. The figures do not include the 1964 crop which would offset some of the loss.

The carryover includes 120,600,000 bushels of wheat on farms, about 92 per cent of it on the Prairies. A year previous, farm-stored wheat totalled 64,700,000 bushels.

There was 136,571,000 bushels of wheat in country elevators at the Lakeside. The rest was

in other terminal elevators or in transit.

The wheat carryover was well below the average of 579,073,000 bushels for the 1954-63 period. The record one-year carryover was 735,546,000 bushels at July 31, 1953.

Stocks of other grains with the previous year's revised figures, farm-stored wheat (barley) 179,376,000 bushels (1,950,278,000); 127,228,000; 117,490,000 (89,245,000); 112,854,000; 776,601,000 (4,139,000); 4,139,000 (11,190,000); 6,809,000 (3,383,000); 5,049,000.

All five major grains add up to a total carryover of about 722,000,000 bushels, five per cent higher than last year's revised estimate of 738,900,000 bushels, but eight per cent below the 10-year average of 835,400,000 bushels.

Quebec Plans 4 Byelections

QUEBEC (CP) — Four by-elections to fill seats in the Quebec legislative assembly will be held Oct. 5 and Premier Lesage predicts victories for his Liberal government in all the constituencies.

The premier, announcing the date of the elections, said October 5 was chosen because the elections should be held before the Queen's visit to Quebec City, scheduled for Oct. 10-11.

At stake in the byelections will be the constituencies of Montreal-Vendôme, Matane, and Saguenay, all won by Liberals in 1962, and Dorchester, taken by the opposition.

The vacancies were caused by the death of three of the members and the appointment of George O'Reilly, the Veritas representative, to the legislative council.

Continuing Education Urged To Keep Druggists In Race

HALIFAX (CP)—A Canadian university professor said here today that a "great need" for continuing education programs in pharmacy.

Prof. Finlay A. Morrison, assistant dean of pharmacy at the University of British Columbia, said the pharmaceutical Association's annual convention that scientific knowledge is changing rapidly and will increase in volume in the future.

It was necessary for druggists to continue learning "if one is to maintain his knowledge," he said.

He said pharmacists already receive the need for continuing education programs to keep abreast of developments in drugs and drug therapy.

He suggested that responsibility for continuing education lies with licensing bodies. "They

Grants Urged For Research On Bug Killers

HALIFAX (CP)—Dr. H. C. Bailey, Committee Chairman on Pesticides and chairman of the Commons special committee on food pesticides and drugs, said here the committee has recommended federal grants be made available for research into effects of insecticides on humans and wildlife.

Dr. Bailey addressed the annual convention of the Canadian Pharmaceutical Association, said the grants would be used to study "effects on humans and wildlife over 10 years of the daily intake of pesticides."

He said the committee also had recommended that the Pest Control Act be amended to prevent unregistered importation of pesticides from the United States.

"There now is no law to prevent a farmer from buying in U.S. pesticides not registered in Canada and using them on his farm," he said. The amendment would close this loophole.

He said the major recommendation of the committee was that a permanent inter-departmental committee be set up to study pesticides. He said this was being done.

Text of Dr. Bailey's speech was made available to the press before presentation.

1st Battalion Canadian Guards Is Given Alert

OTTAWA (CP)—The 1st Battalion, Canadian Guards, at Picton, Ont., has been notified to get ready for possible duty with the United Nations force in Cyprus, informed sources said.

The 1st Guards, the present standby unit for UN duty, would replace the 2nd Battalion, Royal 22nd Regiment, in Cyprus if the UN decides to maintain the force beyond Sept. 26. The Van Doors' tour in Cyprus ends on that date.

There was evident relief in the government Wednesday that Greece and Turkey have replaced units under NATO command after withdrawing them for national purposes over the Cyprus issue.

External Affairs Minister Martin has the Commons denied in effect the suggestion of T. C. Donohoe, New Democratic Party leader, that Britain plans a gradual withdrawal of its contingents from the force.

He said that when rotation of British troops is completed the strength of the British contingent will be about the same as Canada's 1,130 men.
