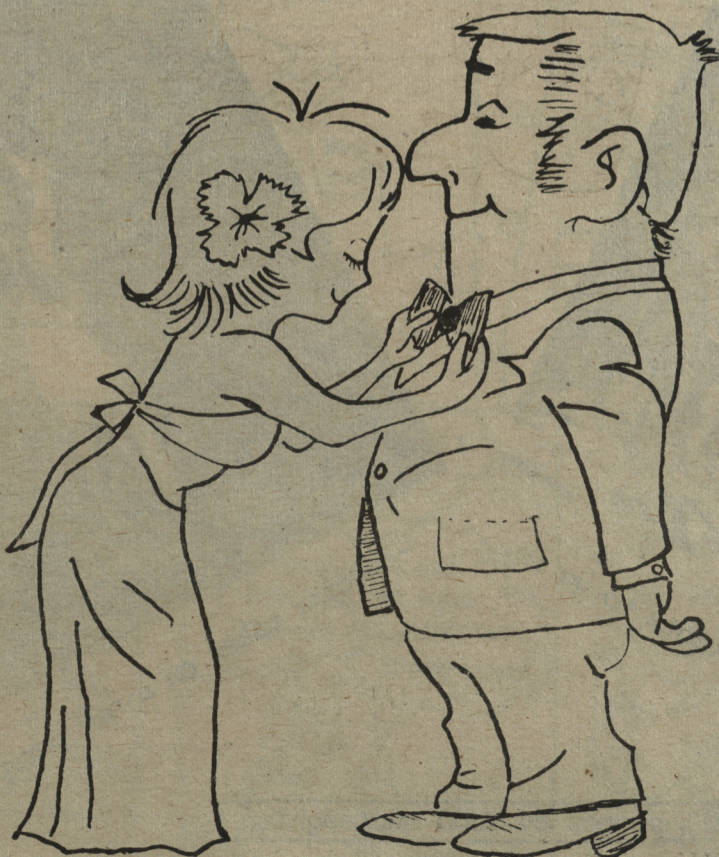
After the hockey game there will be a pub back at the Barn to celebrate the Panther's victory. So get down to the Barn and get warmed up after the game.
